Transforming tobacco: The rise of NGPs and regulatory challenges

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Tobacco data contain total nicotine volumes including e-vapour

Conversions facilitate an overall assessment of total nicotine volume. This approach ensures that all relevant data points are integrated, providing a clear picture of nicotine consumption trends across the industry.

With this new topline figure, we can derive meaningful conclusions about the evolving landscape of e-vapour use and its implications for the industry, as well as a total industry view and increased comparability across categories and datasets.




Structural decline on combustible tobacco sales

Index Growth by Category (excl China) 2024-2029










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RRP prevalence continues to drive total number global users









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Global cigarettes sales sustained by emerging markets



According to the FDA, marketing IQOS products as an MRTP could help addicted adult smokers move away from combustible cigarettes and ultimately reduce exposure to harmful chemicals.



E-vapour products

The EU Parliament recently adopted a report on Cancer prevention and Treatment that acknowledges the potential contribution of e-vapour products in cutting down smoking.
